• Several <u>need</u> to finish the race.


• A few <u>have</u> the right answer.







- Always singular: another, anybody, anyone, anything, each, either, enough, everybody, everyone, everything, little, much, neither, nobody, no one, nothing, one, other, somebody, someone, something
- Always plural: both, few, many, others, and several.



- o All of the chickens have laid eggs.
- One third of the city is unemployed.
- Some of the milk <u>has</u> spilled.

20. THE WORD 'WERE' REPLACES WAS IN SENTENCES THAT EXPRESS A WISH OR ARE CONTRARY TO FACT:

Example: Darts is a popular game in England.

22. Some nouns which are singular in form, but plural in meaning take a plural verb.

(cattle, gentry, vermin, peasantry, artillery, clergy, alphabet, Offspring, information)

Examples: The **police** are getting wise and keeping the file shut.

22. Some nouns which are plural in form, but singular in meaning, take a singular verb.



(Mathematics, classics, ethics, athletics, innings, gallows, economics, poetry, news, measles, news, mumps, electronics, tactics, physics)

• Example: Mathematics is an interesting subject.



23. The number/A number used as singular as well as plural

Examples:

- A number of students are found there.
- The number of people living in streets has reduced.
