- ☐ Analogies develop logic.
- ☐ Analyze two words and identify the relationship between them.
- ☐ Find another pair of words that has the same relationship.



Analogy Construction

□Slack : Slack :: plucky : courageous

Colon stands for the phrase

"is related to"

- □Slack [is related to] Slack
- □ plucky [is related to] courageous

Double colon (::) stands for

"As(in the same way)"

 \Box Or simply—find is to locate as *lose* is to *misplace*.
